**USING MCAFEE VIRUS TOOL STINGER**

**McAfee AVERT Stinger**

Stinger is a stand-alone utility used to detect and remove specific viruses. It is not a substitute for full anti-virus protection, but rather a tool to assist administrators and users when dealing with an infected system. Stinger utilizes next generation scan engine technology, including process scanning, digitally signed DAT files, and scan performance optimizations.

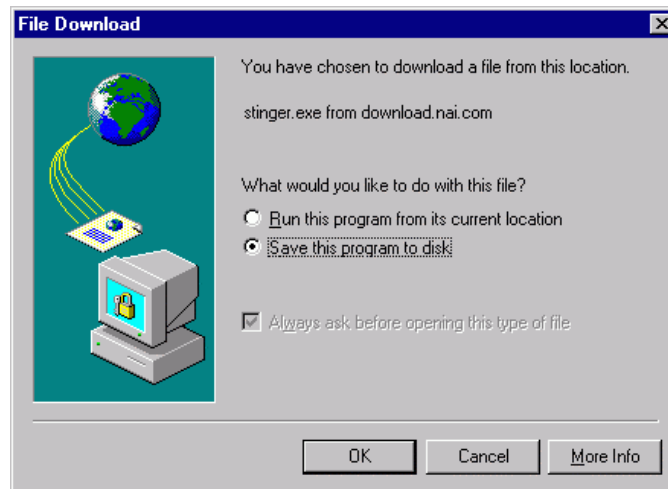
**How do I use Stinger?**

1. Download Stinger from the McAfee website

<http://vil.nai.com/vil/stinger/>

This site will give you a list of the viruses stinger will clean.

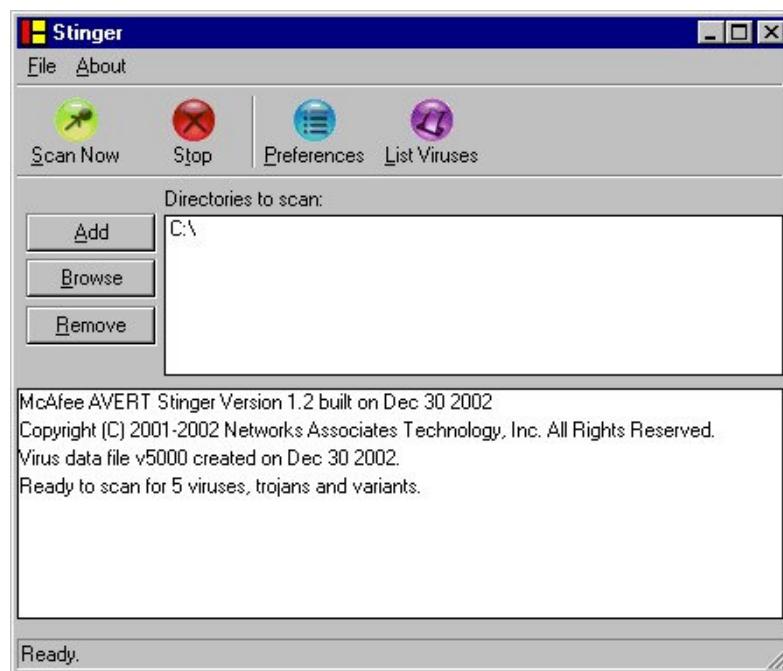
2. When prompted, choose to save the file to a convenient location on your hard disk (such as your Desktop folder).



3. **Windows/XP users need to Turn off System Restore – refer to Fact Sheet on Turning Off System Restore..**
4. When the download is complete, navigate to the folder that contains the downloaded **Stinger.exe** file, and run it by double clicking on it..



5. The Stinger interface will be displayed.



6. If necessary, click the **Add** or **Browse** button to add additional drives/directories to scan. By default the C: drive will be scanned.
  7. Click the **Scan Now** button to begin scanning the specified drives/directories.
  8. By default Stinger will repair all infected files found.
